Cornhole in the Time of Covid-19

We are looking forward to kicking off the 2020 Game of Corns League, benefiting BH Tech Group and its technology education programs for senior citizens.

These adjustments to the way we run our 2020 league will maximize the safety of players, volunteers and our venue's employees. We believe these precautions will keep proper distancing and limit contact on shared equipment. Your safety is our utmost priority and we welcome any further suggestions.

Please Refer to "BH Tech Group Game of Corns - Rules of Play" for general cornhole league match play and scoring; modifications outlined in this document supersede "Rules of Play".

Logistics and Communication

- League nights will be limited to no more than 6 teams playing on 3 outdoor lanes (in a space that typically accommodates 8 lanes).
- BH Tech Group will not encourage general spectators. (Note: Gate City Brewing will be open to the general public).
- Gatherings are expected to be no greater than 25 people. Teams are asked to limit players to a minimum of 2 people/maximum of 4 people and will be joined by 2-4 representatives from BH Tech Group. In addition, Gate City is enforcing state/local capacity guidelines including no groups larger than 25 per 300 square feet throughout the venue.
- Cornhole lanes will be spaced with approximately 8 feet between lanes.
- Players are invited to bring their own official cornhole bags, as long as they are NOT the slick and stick double sided style. We will also have sanitized house bags available for exclusive use by one team for the entire duration of the evening.
- Players will not touch the bags of opposing teams.
- No shaking hands or high fives with teammates or opposing team either during or after games.
- Maintain 6' distancing from other players, teams, volunteers and customers out of respect and safety. Recognize that others may have different levels of risk tolerance and comfort levels and be respectful.
- Upon completion of each match, one person from the winning team will verbally report the score to the BH Tech representative.
- Players agree to NOT attend if they have any symptoms or exposure risks as defined by the [CDC](#).
- Teams will provide player info prior to attending so name tags can be prepared and available for contactless pick-up upon arrival at the event.
- BH Tech Group will communicate all Covid-19 protocols to participants prior to play and post them online.

Sanitation Practices

- Hand sanitizer will be available.

- Gate City requires masks for all staff and BH Tech highly recommends masks for all Game of Corns players, team members, spectators and volunteers when not able to social distance or when not drinking.

- Gate City staff are regularly cleaning/disinfecting bathrooms and have designated bathrooms as 1-in 1-out use only.
